There are routes for experienced racers, as well as for recreational riders who want to enjoy a pleasant ride and enjoy the unique atmosphere of this race. Every year it attracts more than 2,000 mountain bike enthusiasts. It offers three routes of 45, 70 and 105 kilometres.

As always, it starts on the picturesque square in the historical centre of Klatovy. From there it continues along the trails of Šumava. It includes steep hills and even more challenging descents. The route will again feature plenty of cold fords. Varied courses, plenty of refreshments, great spots for spectators, a lavish accompanying program. The goulash and beer for all participants at the finish line is a legend in itself, and the evening will feature three bands at an open-air concert.

Obstacles, running and adrenaline!

The "RUNS" are designed as urban races, focused mainly on running, with obstacles playing a fun yet often difficult role. Runners get to see some interesting places and enjoy the adrenaline rush.

The event is part of the Predator Race series. The competitors have to get over obstacles not only on land, but mainly in the water, enjoying water, mud and sand, jumping into the water and climbing. The race is held around the Great Bolevec Pond in Plzeň. Although the racers will cover more than seven kilometres, this race is still one of the easiest Predator Races.

It offers several categories, competing in elite, open and fun categories. There is also a children's race.













Šumava Ski Marathon

A weekend in the heart of Šumava.

The race leads through beautiful countryside, with facilities in Kvilda. As always, the race is held on both days of the weekend. The standard marathon and half marathon courses cover the usual distances, with both free technique and classic races. Competitors have the opportunity to test their strength against the local landmark - Černá hora. There's no need to worry, as at the top of this climb, everyone enjoys a great feeling of a job well done, not to mention the beautiful views. Otherwise, the racers will ride through classic but always appealing locations such as Horská Kvilda, Modrava and Filipova Hut'.

There are top-class services for the competitors, including a place to store skis and clothing, heated a changing room and a heated tent with hot food and ski-greasing service.

Anyone who wants to come along to the Šumava Ski Marathon yet not compete, can do an open run, i.e. a non-racing ski run. Those interested will have the opportunity to hire cross-country skiing equipment and take a trip around Kvilda. For those who don't want to ski at all, there will be plenty of interesting places around the track. At the start and finish, obviously, but there's also lots to enjoy at Horská Kvilda, Filipova Hut', the road crossings and refreshment stations. There are several opportunities to catch the racers on the track.

Horseracing and the Velká Pardubická

The Velká Pardubická steeplechase is probably the most important social and sports event hosted by the city of Pardubice. It has a tradition dating back to 1874.

When they hear the word Pardubice, many people think of the famous horse race. The Velká Pardubická is held every year on the second Sunday in October. This year will be the 134th year of this famous race, which is preceded by a total of 4 qualifiers. In order for a horse to race in October's Velká Pardubice, it must complete at least one of the four qualifier races on the Pardubice track and finish in at least 5th place, or no more than 20 seconds after the winner. That's what makes the qualifiers so interesting for the spectators. Boxes can also be hired for a truly unforgettable experience. They offer great views and comfortable seating. They also provide catering tailored to suit your needs.


A sporting experience packed with thrills, speed and good fun. The famous motorcycle race has been held at the Pardubice speedway stadium since 1929.

Doing the Jizera 50 route just on skis not enough for you? Then the Jizerská race as part of Běhej lesy is the right race for you.

Běhej lesy is a popular series of races held in various woods and natural locations across the Czech Republic. The event is aimed at promoting a healthy lifestyle and a love of nature, and runners can choose between different distances, allowing even beginners to participate. Races often include side activities such as family runs, children's races and various competitions, making them a great opportunity for families, businesses and running enthusiasts.

The series has two running options for groups and corporate participants, one being the Tandem. This is a run for a man and a woman couple; the team splits to see who will run the longer part of the race and try to get the shortest time on both parts. The next race is the Slowmotion. Here the task is to get the largest possible group of runners together; the more colleagues you have, the higher you'll place - this run is about having the highest total of times.

ČT Author Cup

Over time, the ČT Author Cup has become the largest, most famous and most popular mountain bike event in Czechia. The race is intended primarily for the general public, but also regularly features some top MTB racers and other important sports personalities.

The ČT Author Cup is a popular cycling race held every year in the picturesque setting of the Jizera Mountains. This prestigious race attracts thousands of amateur and professional cyclists from all over the Czech Republic and abroad. The route, which leads through some beautiful countryside and challenging terrain, makes for an unforgettable sporting experience while putting riders' fitness and endurance to the test. The ČT Author Cup is also a social event, a chance for cycling enthusiasts to meet up.

The longer ČT Author Cup route also includes evaluation of the results of company teams, while there is no limit on the number of teams competing for one company. Each team can have a maximum of five members, with a minimum of three. Teams can be mixed, i.e. both men and women. The ranking of the teams is determined by the sum total of the times achieved by the first three members, and in the case of a tie, the position of the team's first competitor is decisive. The starters in the teams are also evaluated individually.

Want to compete in up to 20 sports over the weekend? No problem, Eurohry Doksy offers several sports disciplines that let you test your skills with your colleagues and friends. In some disciplines you compete individually, and as a team in others, but each member has to compete in at least four disciplines, such as: beach volleyball, biathlon, bungee running, cycling, climbing wall, jungle creek, roller skating, football, bowling, archery, football, orienteering, swimming, rafting, table tennis, tennis and rowing.

Horse races at the Zduchovice Resort

The thud of hooves, the spectacle of perfect harmony between riders and horses, the refinement of dressage performances and pony horse races with a summer drink in hand while sitting in the summer restaurant at the Zduchovice Resort.

The Zduchovice Equestrian Centre is one of the leading organisers of competitions in the Czech Republic, both at the national level (it is the traditional organiser of the Czech Championship) and on an international scale (CSIO, CSI*). The end of April and the beginning of June traditionally belong to international competitions, the summer to the Czech championships in the adult and children's categories, dressage and para-dressage, and pony events.




Dark SNOW Moninec

Dark SNOW is a regular February event at the Moninec Ski Resort, with a tradition dating back more than ten years. What makes it so novel? This is a public downhill race that takes place at night!

Both individuals and teams of three can compete. The only condition is that there must be at least one woman in each team. The race itself starts in the early evening and is a two-round competition. Only the top four men and the top four women will go through to the second and final round. The rules are always specified according to the current conditions.

And why at night? The Monínec Ski Resort in the Toulava tourist region offers one of the longest illuminated ski slopes in the country. In previous years, the fastest skiers have reached an average speed of around 80 kilometres per hour.

Czech Truck Prix & NASCAR



The venue hosts races such as the Speed Canoeing World Cups, the World Rowing Championships and a number of junior competitions each year. In September, the Labe Arena plays host to the Czech Dragon Boat Championship, the Czech Sprint Championship and the Czech Fly Fishing Championship.

The whole of the Ústí nad Labem Region's Labe Arena can be hired out for various sporting events, including triathlon, cycling, scooter races and dragon boats. Apart from races, it is also used as a venue for corporate events and sports teambuilding. It offers training rooms, an inline skating track. fitness centre, fishing, catering and accommodation.

Tour de Zeleňák

The oldest amateur road race in the Czech Republic celebrates its 40th anniversary in 2024! The Tour de Zeleňák takes place on a 54km route around the whole of the Šluknov promontory.

The popularity of cycling is growing, as is the number of participants in this race. More than 800 competitors ride the route each year, the record being 950 in 2023. Those who aren't satisfied with the basic track can race in the "Giant Green" category around two circuits. The event also includes historical bikes, mountain bikes and of course children's races.

The accompanying programme starts on Wednesday with a group ride and continues with talks on the Friday. Saturday's sport will be followed by an evening music festival. This year there will be an exhibition featuring world champion Martin Šimůnek, while the weekend ends with a joint training session in the Bohemian Switzerland National Park.






