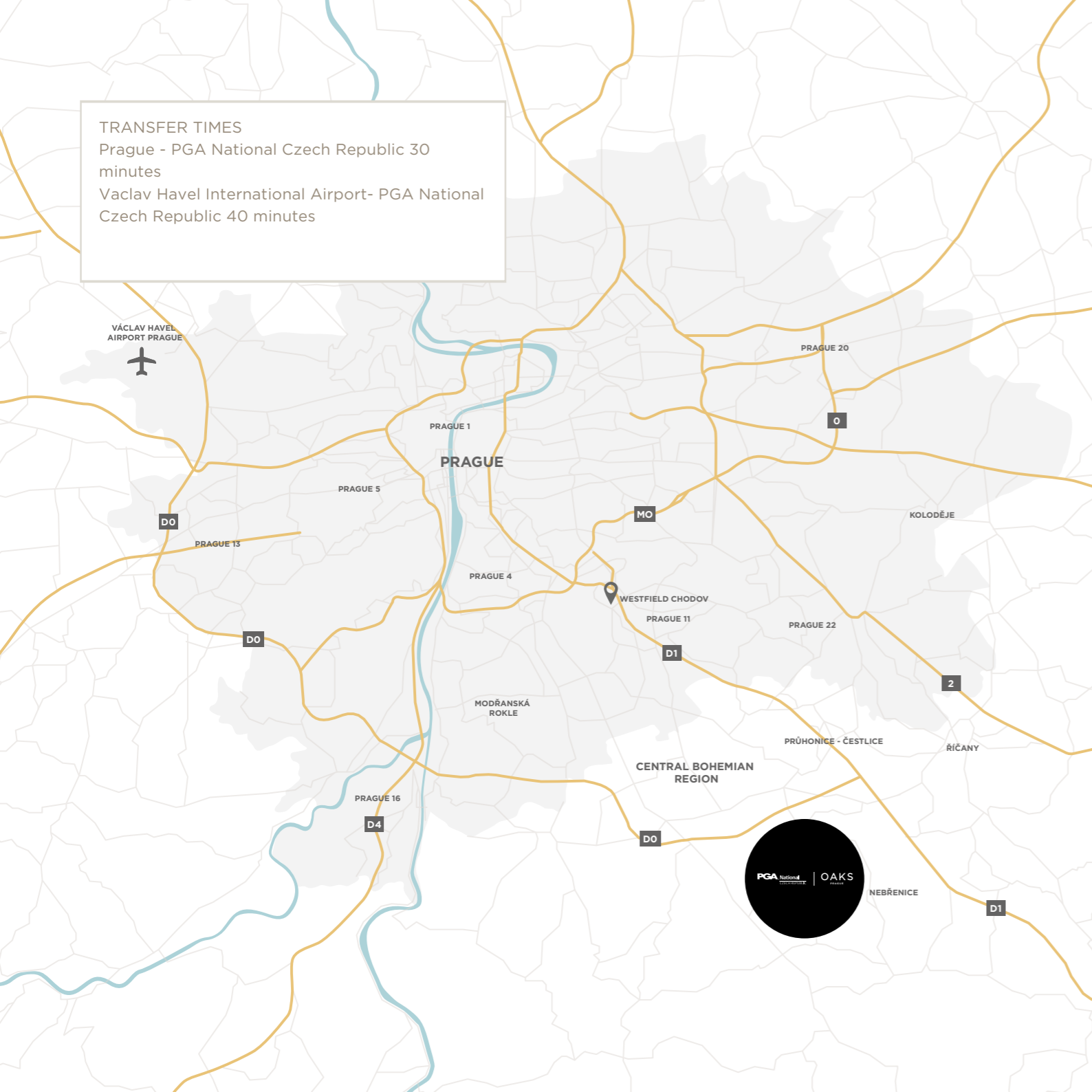

Location

PGA National Czech Republic is located in Nebřenice, a 30 minutes drive from Prague Old Town and 40 minutes from Václav Havel International Airport.

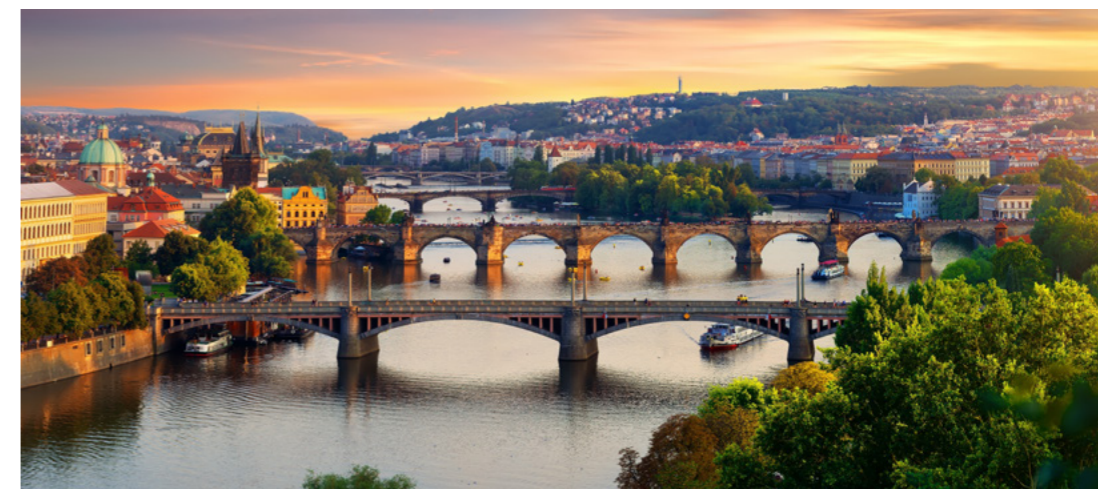
Market positioning & Services

From cathedrals to churches, towers and other magnificent buildings topped with stunning spires, Prague amazes every visitor with its beauty. The Czech metropolis has a lot to offer tourists - beautiful architectural landmarks like the Dancing House, Powder Tower, St Nicholas Church, and other monuments like the Charles Bridge and Astronomical Clock. Magical views from a boat on the Vltava River. No one can deny that Prague is an ideal destination for beer lovers. In the combination with tasty Czech cuisine offering by plenty of restaurants and pubs you have a great tip for a place to rest after a long walk-through Prague.



Charles Bridge

For a romantic stroll, there are few stretches better. Linking Prague Castle to the Old Town, the open-air gallery of Baroque statues lining the Charles Bridge has been inspiring poets and novelists alike for more than six centuries. Come here, and you'll immediately understand why. Head down late at night or early in the morning – it's surprisingly quiet.



Prague Castle

Dominated by the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral, the ninth-century Prague Castle has been a seat of power for Czech emperors, kings and presidents alike. Exploring every corner of these massive fortifications would take an entire trip, so read up in advance and take your pick. Our favourite sights include the tiny houses of Golden Lane, the Romanesque façade of St George's Basilica, and the manicured landscapes of the South Gardens, not even to mention Alphonse Mucha's striking stained-glass windows.



Old Town Square

From the Astronomical Clock to the Church of Our Lady before Týn, the 600-year-old Old Town Square is home to all manner of beautiful historic monuments and buildings. This is the Prague you've seen in pictures – the mechanical wonder of the 15th-century clock, the towering statue of Martyred religious leader Jan Hus and his followers, the uneven twin towers of the Gothic church. Free walking tours start at the northern edge of the square. Come at Christmas and Easter for the atmospheric holiday markets.



Dancing House

This pillar of modern architecture in Prague “danced” onto the Rašínovo Embankment in 1996. The project comes from the drawing board of world-renowned architects Vlado Milunić and Frank O. Gehry. Its concept was inspired by the dance skills of the famous film couple – the stone tower symbolizes Fred Astaire and the glass tower, his partner Ginger Rogers. A gallery and a restaurant with a terrace offering a 360° view of Prague can be visited in the Dancing House.



Czech beer in Prague

The beautiful city of Prague is a playground for beer lovers. Whether you are a pilsner fan or love a light lager or even a heady dark beer, you will find a perfect stein waiting for your arrival. There is a wonderful opportunity to enjoy great Czech beer in Prague



Kampa

This park – an island between the Vltava River and its side branch, Čertovka, where you can see the huge mill wheel of the 15th century former Grand Priory Mill, is one of the most romantic and picturesque places in the city. Not surprisingly, the prestigious traveler’s server VirtualTourist declared it the second most beautiful city island in the world. Grassy areas of the island are widely used for picnics and relaxation.



Petřín Lookout Tower

Petřín Lookout Tower, one of the most prominent landmarks of Prague, was built as part of the Jubilee Exhibition in 1891 as a loose copy inspired by the Eiffel Tower (at a ratio of 1:5). It is 58.70 metres high, and 299 steps lead to its peak, which is at the same altitude as the real Eiffel Tower. The view from its top overlooks not only the whole city, but on a clear day you can see nearly all of Bohemia.

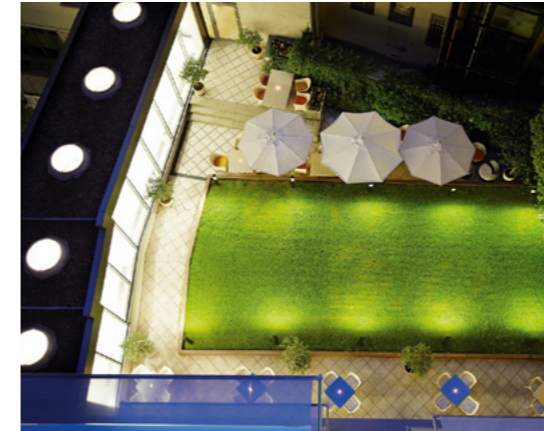


4* Maximilian Hotel
