

Tour the historic centre of Pardubice

Walk through the historic centre of the city of Pardubice on your own or take one of the offered guided tours.

Are you holding an event in Pardubice or nearby? Then you should really find time to see the historic centre. The renaissance Pardubice Château is the jewel of the city. Visitors can view the historic areas linked to the Pernštejn Family and also the secret civil defence bunker and the earthworks surrounding the château. You can also view the newly renovated Automatic Mills. The observation point on the Silo building affords a bird's eye view of the entire city. And you must also visit Penrštýn Square. Climb up Zelená brána (Green Gate) and enjoy the breathtaking view of the surrounding landscape. The Pardubice Tourist Information Centre arranges guided tours of the city on request.

Pastviny Reservoir

Pastviny Reservoir can be found in one of the most beautiful locations in the Orlické Mountains. In summer it offers opportunities for outdoor swimming and boating in rowboats or paddle-boats. You can also enjoy a downhill ride on a scooter or on the bobsled track.

The electric boats, which you can use to explore the reservoir, are a very popular attraction. You can also try riding a scooter down from the ridges of the Orlické Mountains, from Kašparova Chalet to the valley reservoir in Pastviny. Simply get on, push off and ride. You can expect an unparalleled downhill descent, during which you will ride along surfaced roads and forest tracks. There is also a unique, two-loop bobsled track by the reservoir. You will certainly enjoy the adrenalin 'drop' at the end of the first loop, the series of nicely banked bends and the final carousel high above the beach in Pastviny. The area around the reservoir also offers many other activities. There are plenty of cycle and hiking routes here, which will take you to many interesting destinations.

Expedition to the Land of the Celts

The open-air museum is also a suitable venue for holding unusual corporate events or celebrations. 

Ústí nad Labem Region

Adventure hiking along the ridge trail through Bohemian Switzerland

The adventure hiking trail leads nearly 100 km through the most beautiful and often unknown locations in Bohemian Switzerland. Walk through the labyrinth of the sandstone cliffs, enjoy the breathtaking views and the ambiance of the picturesque towns.

The Bohemian Switzerland Ridge Trail leads from the foot of the Ore Mountains to the first hills of the Lusatian Mountains and back again. It depends which end you start the trail from. The sign-posts lead you along ancient and new routes and you can walk the entire trail or decide to walk just a section of it. It is divided into six stages, each 15 - 20 kilometres long.

You will find options for accommodation and refreshment in each stage. You can expect a number of ascents and observation points, such as Jedlová Mountain, Tolštejn Castle, Mariina skála, Šaunštejn cliff castle, Belveder observation point, Pastýřská stěna and the biggest table mountain in Czechia, Sněžník. You will experience a real adventure on the winding cliff trail in Tisá or on Úzké schody near Kyjov.

In the saddle of a bike along the longest river in Czechia, the Elbe

The Elbe Trail is a phenomenon, and anyone can cycle it along the Elbe River in the Ústí Region. It is 96 km long, which means it is best to divide it into several stages. You will discover various sites of natural beauty, sports activities and history along each section.

The cycle route begins in Štětí and you can visit Lobkowicz Château in Roudnice nad Labem, the world-renowned fortress town of Terezín, the royal town of Litoměřice, small wineries in the area around Malé and Velké Žernoseky, Štřekov Castle, the brewery in Velká Březná or the château in Děčín during your expedition along the Elbe Trail.

The section through the Porta Bohemica valley, where the Elbe River has created an unusual landscape with a river valley cut deep into the Central Bohemian Highlands, is a unique experience. The massive sandstone towers can be seen as you cycle through the Elbe Canyon between Děčín and the state border in Dolní Žleby. The individual sections between the towns and cities are approx. 20 to 25 kilometres long. The combination with a boat ride along the Elbe, when you cycle one stage and spend the next on board, is a popular option. You also don't have to necessarily ride a bike along the Elbe Trail! You can also set out on scooter.

Historic open chairlift to the peaks of the Krušné Mountains

The chairlift from Krupka to Komáří vízka was built at the beginning of the nineteen fifties and holds two records. It is the oldest suspended passenger cableway in operation in Czechia and it is also the longest passenger cableway without an interim station in Central Europe. It is also a two-seat chairlift.

The cableway in Krupka is a 101-type chairlift and it is the only one of its kind in the world. There are no other chairlifts of this type in operation. It will take you up to the peaks of the Ore Mountains without any stops, along a 2,438-meter-long route.

During the trip, you will climb 482 meters in elevation in 15 minutes and will be able to enjoy the views of the ridges and into the valley along the way, because you sit sideways to the direction of travel on this chairlift.

You have several options for continuing your journey when you reach the top. You can enjoy some refreshments in the local restaurant or set out on a pleasant walk back. One route leads past the ruins of Kyšperk Castle, the second leads along the Following in the Footsteps of Miners Educational Trail, which leads past Kotelní Lake all the way to Krupka Castle. Both the routes are around 7 kilometres long. The educational trail can also be walked as a circuit with a stop by and a tour of the Starý Martin gallery, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

By paddleboard on the Elbe or on lakes

Paddleboarding is a popular activity that is suitable for everyone. In the Ústí Region, you can enjoy this sport in several versions and in various places. Would you rather paddle down through the Elbe Canyon or navigate the calm waters of lakes Milada, Most, Matylda and Barbora? It's all possible.

You can set out down the river by paddleboard from Děčín in the direction of Hřensko. You will paddle through the beautiful scenery of the sandstone cliffs of the Elbe Canyon along a 12-kilometre route. A visit to the pub in Dolní Zleby is the ideal break in the middle of your journey. But you can also paddle from Roudnice nad Labem to Litoměřice.

The other alternative is the calm waters of the local lakes, which were created by flooding the closed coal mines. Whether you decide to paddle on Milada Lake by Ústí nad Labem or on Barbora near Teplice, or on the Most and Matylda lakes in Most, you will always enjoy yourself - the views, the calm water and plenty of paddling.

We recommend a paddleboard trip on Milada at night, when you can observe life below the water from your board.

Climbing the queen of the Central Bohemian Highlands - Milešovka

The volcanic cone of Milešovka Mountain is the dominant peak of the range and is clearly visible from a great distance. The mountain rises to 836 meters above sea level and is the tallest peak in the landscape of the Central Bohemian Highlands.

Milešovka has always attracted tourists, travellers, artists and natural scientists. Alexander von Humboldt called the view from Milešovka the third most beautiful in the world. The mountain also boasts several records. It is the windiest mountain, with the most storms in this country, which is why it is also called Hromová hora or Thunder Mountain. There is a weather station at the top and the Institute of Atmospheric Physics of the Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic has a permanent office there. It rises above the surrounding area by a respectable 350 meters.

After climbing the mountain through the Milešovka Nature Reservation, which is also a site of European significance in the NATURA 2000 system, you can enjoy some refreshments at the mountain chalet.

If you choose to climb the mountain from the village of Bílka, you can also visit the modern chapel of St. Wenceslas and also the Czech-German trail of friendship with its 14 statues.



Only people equipped with proper ferrata equipment should climb the ferrata. Inexperienced climbers can only climb the ferrata when accompanied by an experienced climber, who assumes personal responsibility for them while climbing. The instructor will climb the route with you and teach you correct practice for safe climbing.

Down Klet' by scooter

You are practically obliged to climb Klet' when visiting our region. If you are preparing to do so, then we recommend an unusual way down - you can ride down the mountain on a scooter. You can choose from three routes in the directions of Krumlov, Zlatá Koruna or Krasetín, which are all around 11 kilometres long and lead through the beautiful natural surroundings of the Blanský les Protected Landscape Area. You can also hire a scooter for the whole day and ride through the historic centre of the town and the surrounding area.

You can reach Klet' in various ways, depending on how much time you have and your physical fitness: it is 8 kilometres by foot to the top of the mountain from the centre of Krumlov, or you can park in the car park by the chairlift and ride up. You can also arrange to have the hire company take you up to the top of the mountain by minibus, but you must arrange the time with them in advance.

Hiking in Šumava - visiting historic locations, through the eyes of trackers or along a guided route

Are you interested in the German names of local settlements, the history and fate of the original settlers? Then you've come to the right place. Grünberg, Rehberg, Schlösselwald, Mittagsberg, Grosshaid, Sattelberg, Wunderbach, Stadln, Frauenthal, Mader, Innergefeld...

We will show you the locations of these former settlements, which were blown apart or demolished by the tanks and bulldozers of the Czechoslovak Armed Forces in the nineteen fifties. We will help you experience the forgotten ambiance of the harsh way of life at the edge or in the middle of the Šumava wilderness. We will visit little-known and difficult to access sites where you can see artefacts abandoned during the sudden expulsion.

Or would you like to track some wolves? The wild wolves that have returned to Šumava? We have plenty of them in Šumava...five packs now regularly mark their territories, hunt and bring up their young. We can find their tracks and traces of their passage in the snow and try to track them for a little while. We may even find grouse, fox or badger tracks. Maybe even lynx tracks. Of course, it depends on the conditions, and we also need a little luck.

Hike with a guide along the Lužnice Trail - Leading Quality Trails Best of Europe

Set out along the only trail in Czechia that is listed as one of the Leading Quality Trails Best of Europe. A guide will take you through the deep valley of the river between Tábor and Bechyně, past old mills and castles. And you can try a quiz on the way.

You and your team can spend time in the countryside on a trail that is part of a network of the best trails in Europe. You can start the trail in the historic centre of Tábor or in Bechyně. You can also choose the length of the trail, from a brief 3 km, through a medium 9-10 km, to a long 15-30 km. We can also arrange a hike lasting several days, with transport back to your starting point. Your luggage will also be transported. Several other activities can be added to the programme - cliff climbing, a visit to the ferratas in Bechyně or in Tábor, boating down part of the trail along the Lužnice River in canoes or a ride on the historic Tábor-Bechyně train (on weekends in summer). A small competition is also prepared for participants in the trail hike - a quiz concerning points of interest along the trail.

By bike or on scooter along the Vltava River trail

Discover the picturesque valley of the Vltava River from Týn to Boršov nad Vltavou. You can try climbing a ferrata with an instructor, visit the chateau in Hluboká nad Vltavou for a photograph together, or visit the Budvar brewery in Budějovice, the city of this beer's birth.

The ideal starting point is Hluboká nad Vltavou, which offers you the option to set out in both directions along the trail. Down river to the aforementioned picturesque Vltava Valley, where you can try climbing the longest ferrata in Central Europe and visit the Baba observation point along the way, or you can set out up-river to České Budějovice for a Budvar beer and play some discgolf in Stromovka park. Anyone can play discgolf, regardless of their fitness or experience. After the game, you can enjoy a picnic in the park on a green meadow.



Boating down the Morava River

Enjoy some romance and privacy on a river with few people! Hire a raft and all the equipment you need and set out in search of adventure! The Morava River can be navigable in the section from Hanušovice to Olomouc, which is approx. 100 km.

The Hanušovice - Postřelmov section is not navigable all year round due to low water levels. However, you can navigate from Postřelmov to Olomouc all year round. This section is approx. 70 km long and can be completed in 3 - 4 days. There are a number of points at which you can start or end your trip on the Morava River. The individual sites are scattered along the river so that the whole river can be used, from one-day trips to a week on the river. There are a range of camps with high-quality facilities available along the river for paddlers.

The Morava is a fast-flowing river with a stony bed, calm stretches above weirs and unique meanders in riparian forests and the [Litovel Pomoraví Protected Landscape Area](#), which is definitely the most beautiful section. The most dangerous section is the section from Hanušovice to Postřelmov and it is only recommended for experienced paddlers.

There are several companies who have boats for hire along the entire river. These offer various crafts, such as plastic canoes and kayaks, inflatable Pálava and Barak canoes, rafts of various sizes and sea kayaks.



Sports shooting complex Jívová

The modern Sports shooting complex Jívová is located in the romantic setting of the Bystřice Valley Nature Park, 15 kilometres as the crow flies from the centre of Olomouc. It is connected to a network or regional cycle routes and signposted hiking routes, which means it provides natural facilities for visitors, with an attractive range of adventure activities on offer.

The complex is the ideal place for active enjoyment of your free time surrounded by nature and offers a constantly expanding range of services for hikers, cyclists and families with children. The complex is suitable for both sports shooters and for families, companies and groups of friends. The complex has an outdoor shooting range and clay target range (skeet and universal trap), with all the related activities. Shooting competitions, instruction and training courses, adventure shooting, even without a firearms licence, defence training and seminars can all be arranged. The shooting range is intended for sports and recreational shooting and for government armed forces training.

The main building houses a fully equipped instruction room for 40 people, and a weapons and ammunition shop. There are refreshments with an outdoor barbecue and seating available, indoors with a fireplace and also an outdoor covered terrace, which is an excellent venue for your event with buffet catering. 

Baťa Canal

The modern history of the Baťa Canal, formerly a water route for transporting lignite, began in 1992, when the first boat demonstrated navigation of a small section of the canal. Much has happened since then.

Enjoy a sightseeing cruise by pleasure boat, or use the various boat, houseboat, canoe or raft hire services on this unique 53-kilometre-long water route, which was constructed between 1934 and 1938. Discover one of the 13 historic locks, the unique technical monuments or enjoy the sandy river meanders and unique nature. You can also enjoy all this while cycling along the cycle route along the edge of Baťa Canal.

One of the most important tourist destinations in East Moravia is also planning more innovations in the following years. Construction of a lock in Bělov is planned, along with a recreational harbour for 83 boats in Kroměříž. Along with extension of the Baťa Canal southwards to Hodonín and northwards to Kroměříž, which means that this recreational water route will be extended from its current 52 kilometres to 72 kilometres in 2027.

Bečva Cycle Route

The beautiful nature of the Beskydy Mountains, traditional Wallachian wooden timbered cottages and easy cycling. The actual Bečva River begins past the confluence of the Rožnov Bečva and Vsetín Bečva rivers at Valašské Meziříčí, but it is the sections along the Rožnov Bečva and the Vsetín Bečva that are the most romantic.

The Rožnov Bečva river begins by the Horní Bečva Reservoir, which offers opportunities for swimming and relaxation to cyclists. You can continue in the direction of Rožnov nad Radhoštěm, where it is worth getting off your bike and visiting the Rožnov open-air museum. Cyclists can also visit the summer swimming pool and Gibon fun park. The cycle route gradually leaves the upper reaches of the Beskydy Mountains and leads to the destination of Valašské Meziříčí, which offers many reasons to stop and opportunities for refreshment. The total length of the route is just under 31 kilometres.

The Vsetín Bečva river begins above Velké Karlovice in mountainous terrain and leads through one of the most beautiful mountain valleys in the country. The route continues through Velké Karlovice, through a landscape settled by glass-makers many centuries ago. You can admire their creations in the Glass Making Museum by the information centre. There is also the Balaton reservoir between Karolinka and Nový Hrozenkov, which is very appealing in summer with its sandy banks and tasty food and drink. The route continues towards Vsetín, down a small hill, and offers beautiful views of the surrounding landscape, which will amaze you with its picturesque buildings and grazing sheep. The route follows the Vsetín Bečva river very closely, with some small detours, and the total route is just under 57 kilometres long.

Cyril Methodius Route - following in the footsteps of the Slavic Apostles

The route refers to the cultural roots of the Slavs linked to the arrival of the two brothers from Thessaloniki, Saint Cyril and Saint Methodius, in Great Moravia. The route, which erases the boundaries between pilgrim and tourist, connects significant places of pilgrimage in Moravia and Bohemia. Welcome to the pilgrimage route, which is nearly 930 kilometres long, connects a total of 6 regions in the Czech Republic, 3 countries and numerous monuments. Welcome to the Cyril-Methodius Route.

The focal point of the trails is Velehrad, a place of pilgrimage and the destination of trails leading from five directions. From Jablunkov through Pustevny in the Beskyd Mountains, from Skalka u Trenčína in Slovakia through Uherské Hradiště, or from Šaštín through the Greater Moravia sites of Kopčany and Mikulčice. You can also walk from Levý Hradec by Prague through Sázava and Křtiny, or from Svatý Kopeček through Olomouc and Kroměříž.




Visit Zlín Zoo and discover the world


Stingray Bay, the concept and size of which makes it the only one of its kind in Europe, is also a real treat. The Jaguar Trek display, which was built in 2022 and shows visitors what a tropical forest looks like, is one of the exhibits newly opened in recent years. The entire complex for jaguars covers an area of over 2,000 m² and is the biggest of its kind in Europe. The Gora Ark for vultures was opened in 2023. It became home to 20 vultures and other African bird species. The aviary is 80 m long and the only one of its kind in Czechia. The Kerala Display is named for the state in South India. This new addition in 2023 was created by transforming the original Asian Aviary.

Soos National Nature Reservation - the Czech Yellowstone near Františkovy Lázně

The Soos National Nature Reservation is located near Františkovy Lázně. This is a large peat bog and fen, with a great number of mineral springs and pure carbon dioxide bubbling up in so-called mofettas. The educational trail leads along the bottom of a dried-up lake, which used to contain salt (mineral) water.

A number of protected species of animal live in the reservation and it is also home to many species of wetland and salt-loving plants. The area was declared a reservation in 1964 and covers 221 ha, only part of which is open to the public along a 1.2 km long educational trail, which leads along the bottom of an extinct lake that contained salt (mineral) water.

The complex includes a natural geological park, a museum with a “Nature of the Cheb and Soos regions” exhibition, a pavilion with a “History of the Earth” and palaeontology exhibition with large reproductions of pictures by Zdeněk Burian and life-size models of prehistoric lizards, a wild animal rescue station and “Bird world” display. The wild animal rescue station is a member of the National Network of Rescue Stations of Czechia.

Natural rope centre at the Svatý Linhart complex

The Svatý Linhart natural rope centre is an excellent destination for outings, for team-building and also for groups of sports enthusiasts, who enjoy testing their physical fitness and mental resilience.

There are circuits with rope and top-rope obstacles for children and adults here. The rope centre is located right next to the Svatý Linhart Forest Centre, where you can hire a training room or outdoor pavilion.

Through the landscape of the stone masons to the tallest mountain the Vysočina Region

Have you wanted to visit the Himalayas, but haven't had the opportunity yet? Don't worry, Geopark Vysočina offers you a unique opportunity to walk through an area that was as high as the Himalayan giants in the distant past.

Stone mason paradise - covers an area spreading from Telč to the tallest peak of the Vysočina Region - Javořice. It's dominant point and heart is Míchova skála - two wind-eroded cliff towers that are around 13 m tall. Legend says that the last wolf in the Jihlava mountains was shot not far from here in 1829. The stonemasonry tradition is the symbol of the entire region, because granite used to be quarried here. You can visit the stonemasonry museum and the underground tunnels in Mrakotín. Between Lhotka and Rásná you can encounter the ruins of Štamberk Castle and the stone sea.

Hikers can take one of three educational trails in the geopark, for example from Roštejn Castle to Javořice. In Telč itself, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, you can visit the Telč underground and other local exhibitions, including the chateau. There is also the rope park in Lhotka, Chadimův mill or the organic farm in Horní Dubenky.



The picturesque valley of the Jizera River, the silhouettes of the cliff towers and other sites of natural beauty in the Bohemian Paradise were discovered by tourists and locals centuries ago. Even today, the area along the Jizera River from Malá Skála to Dolánky is a highly sought-after and popular destination for outings or leisure activities.

The ideal starting point at Malá Skála is the iconic Žlutá plovárna (Yellow lido) built on pillars. The entire lido complex has its origins in the nineteen thirties. The original lido building was popular among Prague residents during the First Republic. Famous figures such as Jiří Voskovec, Jan Werich and others visited the lido. Today, the lido is part of an outdoor complex with refreshments, boat and scooter hire and a rope centre. It offers the ideal opportunity to relax on the grassy banks, with beautiful views of the cliff-top castle and a natural swimming area with still and clean water above the weir. You can get in a canoe or raft, enjoy going over the weir, paddle 9 km on a calm river, buy something to eat and drink at Dolánky u Turnova and race back to Žlutá plovárna by scooter along the Greenway Jizera cycle route. This is a suitable half or whole day activity for school or corporate groups as a team-building event.





Following Gunther's Trail

The Bohemian-Bavarian Gunther's Trail is a long-distance pilgrimage trail, which connects important sites linked to the mediaeval hermit and the first inhabitant of Šumava - St Gunther. The trail is divided into 9 individual stages of a total length of 162 km.

Gunther's Trail begins by the Danube in the Bavarian town of Niederalteich, at Gunther's Monastery. It leads through Rinnach, where he founded a monastery, through Zwiesel to the Czech-German border crossing of Gsenget, from where it leads through the deep forests of Šumava and its picturesque foothills, into the interior of the Bohemian countryside. It passes through Prášily, Hartmanice, Sušici, Horažďovice and Chanovice to Blatná, where the signs marking Gunther's Trail end in the countryside. From Blatná, Gunther's Trail follows the corridor of the Via Nova route, which leads all the way to Prague, where St Gunther is buried at Břevnov Monastery.

Gunther's Trail is divided into 9 one-day stages of a total length of 162 km, of which 3 stages are in Germany, 1 stage leading across the border crosses both territories and 5 stages lead through Czechia. On the Czech side of the border, the trail mostly uses Czech Hiking Club routes and is signposted in the terrain using Czech Hiking Club signs with the name Gunther's Trail (Vintřova stezka). On the Czech side of the border, the trail is complemented by 6 one-day hiking circuits, which begin and end at the same place and provide an opportunity for a one-day family outing, during which one can see the legacy of St Gunther, and also other attractive destinations, for instance castles, churches, chapels or springs.

A belt of forest nearly one hundred kilometres long, rare nature combined with the history of an inaccessible military zone and dozens of kilometres of cycling and hiking trails: this is the dominant point of the Brdy Protected Landscape Area. Together with the surrounding towns, it is a paradise for those who love peace and quiet.

The Brdy Protected Landscape Area Visitors' Centre was opened in a former agricultural complex in August 2023. The farm section of a hunting château in the centre of the Brdy Mountains was transformed into an attractive place with an interactive exhibition devoted to nature, the history of the mountains and also its long military past. There is an outdoor playground for children and also a 'forest' chapel on the former site of an actual chapel.




