The festival of light "Blik blik"

21 – 23 March (Fri – Sun)

The popular BLIK BLIK light festival will celebrate its round anniversary in 2025. The festival was first launched in 2015 as part of the title European Capital of Culture. Its theme will be Contrasts, or the dialogue between technology and history. It takes place annually in various locations right in the streets of Pilsen and attracts visitors to attractive light installations and contemporary digital art from artists from all over the world. Visitors will find 20 installations on the route from náměstí Republiky (Republic Square) through DEPO2015 to TechTower a revitalized former brewery building, now a high-tech science and technology center.





12 – 14 September (Fri – Sun)

The festival of microbreweries Sun in the Glass (<u>www.slunceveskle.cz</u>) takes place in the microbrewery Purkmistr in Černice. With the arrival of autumn, Pilsen traditionally hosts this popular Festival, where you can taste unusual beer specials from the Czech Republic and abroad.


