

- 2. The local currency is the koruna (although euros are accepted everywhere). The average exchange rate is 26 korun for 1 euro).
- 3. The Czech Republic is famous for its fine crystal art, wooden toys, garnets, hand-knit shawls, handmade tablecloths and puppets, painted eggs, china and antiques.
- 4. The Rolling Stones paid to light Prague Castle, listed in the Guinness Book of Records as the largest ancient castle in the world.
- 5. The sugar cube, contact lenses and the word "robot" come from the Czech Republic.
