Bedřich Smetana: 200th anniversary


Bedřich Smetana (*2 March 1824 in Litomyšl – 12 May 1884 in Prague)






Český Krumlov: Baroque & Open air theater



Morellos notgedrungenes Booking war so interessant wie riskant – aber wenn man was riskiert, geht eben auch mal was schief.
